**REASON FOR PROJECT:**

While looking at renovation needs the following was also to be assessed: Life Safety issues, ADA accessibility, sense of entrance and identity to the building on the exterior, entrance on the interior to have lounge area and R/A desk station for 24 hour staffing, Resident Hall Director suite to be uniform so that staff can be shifted from hall to hall as needed. There should be areas for students to meet, including spaces for planned events (i.e., lectures, seminars, studying). Each floor should have a communal lounge area, visibly open and inviting to the floor, one kitchen and laundry should be provided per hall at a minimum, possibly one per two floors. Develop opportunities for a variety of room/suite arrangements, including en suite arrangements. Locations can be intermixed throughout halls and floors.
